

Tic Tac Toe Valentine Card



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Sweet Conversations
- **Card Stock** – Basic Black, Basic White, Real Red
- **Stamp Pads** – Memento Tuxedo Black (132708); Real Red
- **Misc.** – Paper Trimmer. Black gingham ribbon, vellum, clear embossing powder, heat tool, black twine, small button, adhesive, die-cutting machine, Messages Die, mini glue dots

Measurements:

- Basic Black: 5" x 10", scored at 5"
- Real Red: 4 ¾" x 4 ¾"
- Basic White: 4" x 4"

Instructions:

1. Create your black card base.
2. Using small heart and red ink, randomly stamp around the edges of red cardstock (you'll cover up the middle with the white layer so no need to stamp here).
3. To create your "grid" for ribbon, score the white piece lightly on each end at approx 1 3/8" from each end. Turn cardstock and repeat. This will give you the lines on which to put down your ribbon.
4. Attach ribbon over each line, lining up to create squares that are as close to the same size as possible. Secure your ribbon on the back with adhesive or tape.
5. Stamp an "X" in the desired squares and a red heart in each remaining square. You want to end up with three hearts on the middle row.

6. Use a die cutting machine with red card stock and the heart that matches the ones you've stamped, cut them out and attach over the stamped one using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Stamp "happy valentines day" in Memento black ink and then immediately pour clear embossing powder over, tap off excess and heat. Cut out using the banner on Messages Die.
8. Adhere to the card, strategically placing a glue dot under the "h" in happy so you won't see it through the vellum. Put another glue dot on the other end of the stamped vellum piece and then attach button (with twine tied through) on top with a couple of glue dots.
