Paper (including Cutting Dimensions):

Basic White Cardstock (CS) (159276) 2-3/4" x 4", scrap for sentiment

Starry Sky Cardstock (CS) (159263) 4-1/4" x 11" scored at 5-1/2"

6" x 6" Designer Series Paper {DSP} – In Color 2022-24 (159253) Parakeet Party 6" x 6",

cut into four pieces: 3-3/4" x 5", 1" x 3-3/4", 2-1/4" x 3-3/4", 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut DSP as follows,
 - place left edge of DSP at 3-3/4" and cut; turn this piece 90° (so 6" edge is along the top of Trimmer); place left edge at 5" and cut; and,
 - place 6" edge of remaining piece along top of Trimmer and left edge at 2-1/4; cut.
1. Place 11" edge of Sky CS along top of Trimmer and left edge at 3"; cut.
2. Emboss small piece of Starry Sky CS with Folder. NOTE: Spritz with water first if you like a deeper impression.
3. Flip DSP square to pattern you're not using for the front/inside; adhere hexagon with glue.
4. Assemble Card as follows:
 - Fold Card Base then burnish crease with bone folder;
 - Adhere large DSP inside Base with glue;
 - Add White CS, centering on DSP so CS will not show when card is closed;
 - Attach remaining DSP to front left flap with glue making sure pattern matches inside of card;
 - Add embossed Sky CS to left flap, placing glue only on the left side of CS; and,
 - Using Sweet Sorbet Ink, stamp sentiment onto scrap of Basic White CS and cut out using smallest banner die. Add stamped sentiment piece at an angle to card front using glue.
